Joshua 1:1-3, 5-6 NIRV

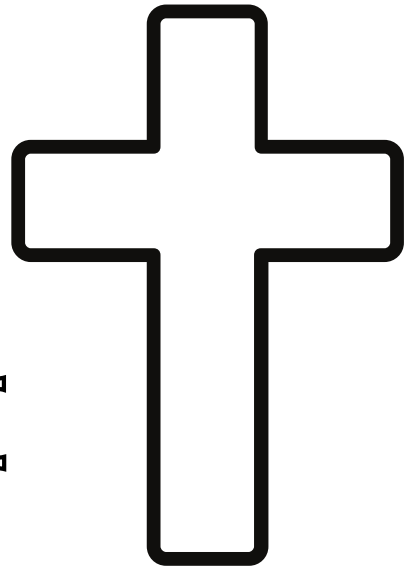
QUESTIONS:
